- I. Fear the Temptation to Avoid Taking a Strong Stance on the Savior. (v.1-2)
- II. Fear the Temptation to Stand on Middle Ground. (v.3-6)
 - Conforming to being a people -pleaser never yields satisfaction.
 - It takes more than human sentiment to bring a person to Christ.
- III. Fear the Temptation to Ignore Warnings to Calm Chaos. (v.7-9)
- IV. Fear the Temptation to Believe Authority Can Be Obtained Rather Than Received. (v.10-11)
 - Jesus had already completely yielded to His Father.
 - Pilate thought he could bully Jesus.
- V. Fear the Temptation to Set Status Above Salvation. (v.12)
 - Pilate's loyalty to Caesar clouded his choice of a Savior.
- VI. Fear the Temptation of Placing Expectations Above the Promise of Scripture. (v.13-16)
