“Meet the Great I AM- And Never Go Without the Hand of God.”  
John 7:1-36

- I. Never Without the Hand of God Again- Because of One Affection and One Allegiance. (v.1-10)
  - A. Establish one supreme affection.
  - B. Establish one supreme allegiance.
  - C. The penalty of foregoing THIS affection and THIS allegiance is beyond restoration.
    - 1. We cannot believe. (v.10-12)
    - 2. We WILL hate Jesus.
    - 3. We are influenced by every opinion.
  
- II. Never Without the Hand of God Again- Because HIS Person Penetrates to Our Depths. (v.11-19)
  - A. HIS person penetrates and we know we have Him. (v.11,17)
    - 1. HE is AT the mercy seat when we cry in despair!
    - 2. HE is IN the Word as we search every page.
    - 3. HE is IN the midst of His people, even a few.
    - 4. HE is IN the furnace of trial WITH you.
  - B. HIS person penetrates and draws us near. (v.11)
    - 1. Is HE on the throne of my heart?
    - 2. Is HE at the root of my joys?
    - 3. Is HE visible in my attitudes? Actions? Words?
    - 4. Is HE directly in front of me- at my terminus- Is every step one movement closer to eternity with Him?
  
- III. Never Without the Hand of God Again - Because His Claims captivate Me. (v.20-36)
  - A. His character more than supports His claims.
  - B. His Doctrine leads me to immeasurable knowledge.
  - C. His relationship to His Father guarantees my destiny.
