I. Take the Road less Traveled by Design

- We know we are not seeking permanent residence here.
- We know our God will supply our needs; we are here only to get past this famine.
- We know we must trust in Promises others don't comprehend.

II. Take the Road Less Traveled by Dogged Determination to Overcome Difficulties.

- Shortages of resources can be overcome because of our Guide's abundance. (v.13)
- Changes in Situations can be overcome because of our King's stability. (v.17)
- Loss of Freedom here can be overcome by Our Savior's permanent eternal home (v.20-21)
- Uncertainty of our Future Can be Overcome by Dependence on our Sovereign Lord (v.31)

III. Take the Road Less Traveled by Marching to a Distinct Drum Beat

- Our blessings come from a different source. (v.8,10)
- Our final destination requires a narrower path.
- Our ultimate satisfaction calls for a different target. - Matthew 6:33
